Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Apa seek 40 Ngā Wairiki-Ngāti Apa Rangatahi volunteers between the ages of 13-18yrs to undergo an intensive Rangatahi Scholarship Programme which aims to:

- Promote wellbeing of Rangatahi through increased levels of challenging activity and improved initiatives,
- Develop Rangatahi as leaders and champions of tomorrow in their whānau/hapū and Iwi communities using kaupapa Ngā Wairiki-Ngāti Apa strengths-based approaches,
- Provide Rangatahi with support and mentoring during the course of the programme and beyond
- Help our Rangatahi graduate from Secondary/Tertiary education with the right qualifications for their choice of a career

This Programme will take place during the following periods:

6-17 July 2015

28 September – 9 October 2015

12-20 December 2015, and

At times required outside of these periods

With a growing emphasis on tikanga Ngā Wairiki-Ngāti Apa, our Rangatahi have the opportunity to explore their identity with access to a variety of taonga tuku iho ranging from Technology, Outdoor Adventures, Customary Fishing, Water Safety, Agriculture, Environmental, Nutrition, Sport, Fitness, health and many more.

With whānau and hapū support and encouragement, these opportunities will help our Rangatahi to make the best decisions for their futures as much as help our Rangatahi find their place in the world we live.

#### **How the Programme Works**

- Rangatahi will develop a 'one-to-one' mentoring relationship with a Tangata Tiaki (Mentor) in their community to support them throughout the course of the programme.
- Rangatahi will explore local Iwi and government leadership.
- Rangatahi will better understand their world view as a young Maori-growing up in their whānau, hapū, iwi and wider community.
- Rangatahi along with their whānau and hapū will attend a series of wānanga throughout the year, focused on growing and developing leadership and networks

### **Who is eligible for the programme and how will Rangatahi be selected?**

The individual marae and hapū within Ngā Wairiki-Ngāti Apa will select Rangatahi that meets the following criteria:

- Is aged between 13-18 years
- Is actively involved in contributing to the wellbeing of their community at some level
- Is committed to being involved in this kaupapa
- Has support from whānau/hapū/marae to participate in the programme
- Is open minded and are willing to contribute to discussions and participate in all organised programmed activities
- Is well organised and have the ability to manage their time and commitments effectively
- Is innovative, self-managing and adaptable.
